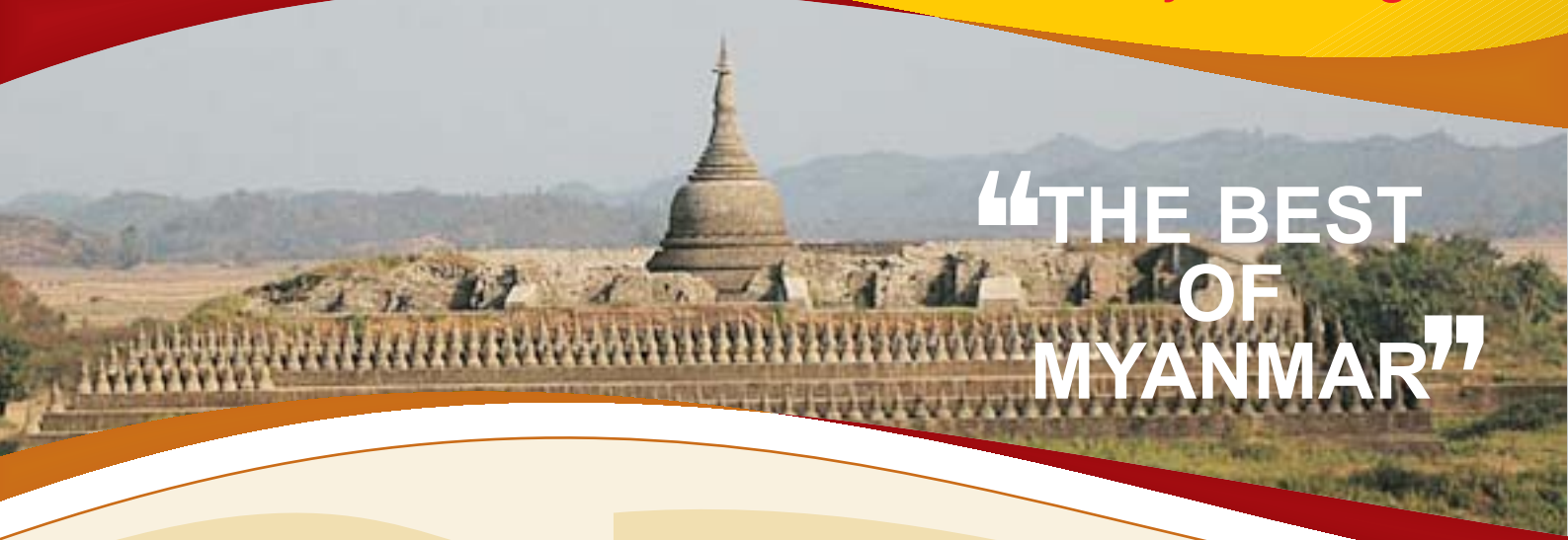

Day 1
Arrival Yangon airport by TG 305 (ETA : 1845)

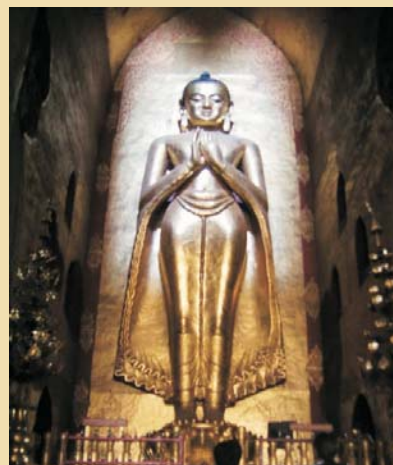


Arrive in Yangon and transfer to hotel. Yangon, formerly known as Rangoon, is still a relatively quiet and charming city. Its impressive colonial and spiritual heritage makes Yangon one of the most fascinating and authentic capitals of South-East Asia. Meet and greet by hotel local guide. Transfer to hotel for check in. Dinner at local restaurant. Overnight at Nikko or Park Royal in Yangon.(D)



Day 2
Yangon - Bagan by morning flight.

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to airport for flight to Bagan. Sightseeing Bagan by visiting: Nyaung Oo Market; Shwezigon Pagoda - the prototype for later Myanmar pagodas built by King Anawrahta; Ananda Temple - King Kyansittha's masterpiece and the crowning achievement of the early style temple of architecture; Kyansittha Umin; Thatbyinnyu Temple - the highest building on the Bagan plain; and Htilominlo Temple - the largest temples of Bagan. Lunch at Sun Set Garden Restaurant. Evening visit to Lacquer-ware making home cottage; Manuha Temple; Myinkaba Gubyaukgyi Temple - known for its wall paintings depicting scenes from the Jataka; and Dhamanyangyi Temple. Evening, sunset view of Bagan from Bupaya or Shwesandaw Pagoda. Dinner and overnight at Myanmar Treasure hotel in Bagan. (BLD)



Day 3
Bagan - Mandalay by morning flight.

After breakfast at hotel, transfer to airport for flight to Mandalay. Meet & transfer to hotel. After check in hotel, sightseeing Mandalay to Mahamuni Image - a bronze Buddha image castled during the lifetime of Buddha himself, Tapestry works; Wood carving & bronze casting workshops; Marble carving workshop and silk weaving home cottage. Lunch at Mya Nandar restaurant with Myanmar Food. After lunch, continues visit to : Mandalay Palace, Shwenandaw Monastery - noted for its exquisite wood carvings; gold leaf beating workshop; Atumashi Monastery; Kuthodaw Pagoda - known as the world biggest book and finish the tour by visiting Mandalay Hill to watch the sunset and the panoramic view of the city. Dinner at Ko's Kitchen Restaurant with Thai Food. Overnight at Mandalay Hill Resort in Mandalay. (BLD)





Day 4 :
Mandalay - Heho/Inle by morning flight.



After breakfast at hotel, transfer to airport for Heho. Upon arrival at Heho airport, from Heho, enjoy a scenic drive to Inle Lake, one of Myanmar's bestknown sights. The Intha people, a tribe of Mon descent, mostly inhabit the lakeshores and floating villages. On arrival at Nyaung Shwe village, transfer by boat to start a sightseeing tour of Inle Lake including a chance to see the leg-rowing fishermen. Continue to see the floating gardens, built up from strips of water hyacinth and mud and anchored to the bottom with bamboo poles. There are also floating villages like Ywama, the lake's downtown, where a floating market is held every five days. In the afternoon continue to Phaung Daw Oo Pagoda, the weaving village of Inpawkhon and the jumping cat monastery. Check into hotel in the afternoon. Dinner and overnight at Myanmar Treasure hotel in Bagan. (BLD)

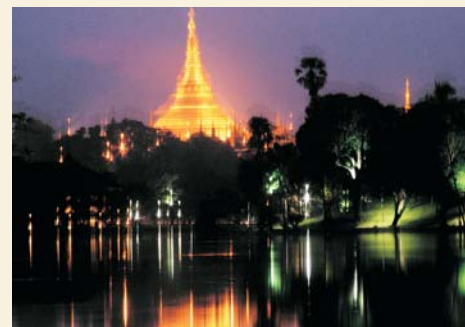

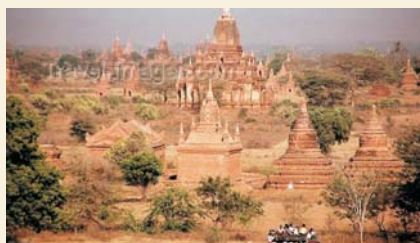
Note GV2 and GV4 will be provided with station English guide only. If you need Chinese, it will have surcharge.

Free and easy shopping at Bogyoke (Scott) Market and finish by bustling China town and finished by visiting Shwedagon Pagoda - 2500 years old the world famous stupa having a beautiful sun-set. Farewell dinner at local restaurant. Overnight at Nikko or Park Royal in Yangon. (BLD)

Departure from Yangon by TG 304 (ETD : 1005)

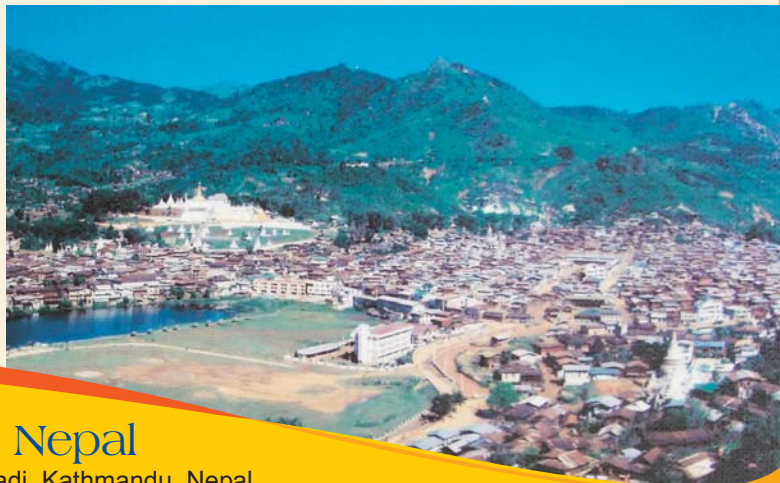
